



NRA BASICS OF SHOTGUN SHOOTING

MAY 2, 2020

This course is for that person who would like to learn more about the sport of clay shooting, or would like to take the first step required to becoming a NRA certified shotgun instructor.

Shotgun is a favorite activity for Scout troops. It teaches hand-eye coordination, focus and balance – plus it's a lot of fun. For Scouters with active Troops, the Shotgun range at Camp Sequassen can provide a memorable weekend activity.

While you don't need to be an instructor to teach the Shotgun Merit Badge, you do need to be familiar and comfortable with the sport.

(Please note: BSA requires live fire requirements to be supervised by a NRA certified Shotgun Instructor.)

The NRA Basics of Shotgun Shooting course introduces students to the knowledge, skills and attitude necessary for owning and using a shotgun safely and responsibly. Through this course you will learn about gun safety, shotgun parts and operation, ammunition, shotgun shooting fundamentals and activities.

The first part of the course will focus on classroom instruction. After lunch, we'll head up to the range for some practical shooting experience.

The NRA Basics of Shotgun Shooting course will also help prepare anyone who is interested in taking that next step – Shotgun Instructor. This course is a prerequisite for the NRA Shotgun Instructor course, which is scheduled for September 18-20, 2020.
