DAY USE OF CONNECTICUT YANKEE COUNCIL CAMPS

BY SCOUT UNITS, GROUPS, AND SCOUTING FAMILIES BEGINNING JUNE 27, 2020

General Information:

- Council Camps are open to Scout units, groups, and in-council families.
- Only Scouts units that are registered to Chartered Organizations from within the State of Connecticut are permitted to access Council Camps at this time.
- At least one member of the in-council family must have a current registration with the Boy Scouts of America, with a unit chartered by Connecticut Yankee Council
- Scout units may invite prospective new members to participate. In-council families may invite guests; however, the number of guests may not exceed the number of family members.
- Camp Sequassen, Hoyt Scout Reservation, and Wah Wah Taysee are open 7 days a week; Camp Pomperaug is open Friday to Sunday. Deer Lake Scout Reservation will remain unavailable until mid-August.
- Camp properties will be open from 8:00 am to 9:30 pm, however Camp Pomperaug will be open Fridays from 6:00 pm to 9:30 pm, Saturdays from 8:00 am to 9:30 pm, and Sundays from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- All groups must register at least 48 hours in advance so that group leaders can be updated on any area closings, current Council guidance and policies and federal/state/BSA regulations and guidance. Groups will select a specific site or facility.

GUIDELINES FOR UNIT OUTDOOR PROGRAMS

AS OF JUNE 19, 2020

Venues which allowed private gatherings as large as 100 people outdoors and 25 people indoors. These limitations apply to Scouting activities when followed in conjunction with Youth Protection guidelines.
