## Scout Day at Lime Rock Connecticut Yankee Council

The Green Tickets are for Adults and Youth 11 years and up. The Orange Tickets are for Cub Scouts and Youth 4-10 years of age.

Scout Day at Lime Rock promises to be a fun and exciting event.

During your stay, please observe the following rules:

Please distribute group tickets ahead of time or be sure the first person to arrive at the site has tickets to hand out to everyone else in your group. If you are meeting your group to distribute tickets on site, you will need to wait for your families at the entrance, not in the camping area. **Everyone must have their tickets to enter the gate**.

Campers may begin arriving after 6:00 PM Friday evening, October 1. **Please do not arrive before 6 PM.** Enter through the Main (Infield) entrance and present tickets and completed, signed consent/waiver forms for all occupants of your vehicle. (Note: Waivers for minors attending without their parents, must be notarized.)

After you cross the bridge, the Scout pavilion (look for the flashing yellow light) is on the right. If your unit representative has marked your camping area on the map, a committee member will be able to assist you in finding your group. Please let us know where your unit has set up camp. It gets dark early and can be difficult to locate your group in the camping area after nightfall. Use of cell phones is recommended although cell service can be weak in the park. Cars should be parked in the parking lot after equipment is off-loaded.

If arriving Friday evening, you may eat before arrival, bring your dinner with you, or go to <a href="https://limerock.com/food-and-beverage">https://limerock.com/food-and-beverage</a> for a list of area restaurants.

Ground fires are not permitted. Raised firepits and stoves/grills on stands may be used. Food concessions are available to purchase meals on Saturday.

If you want to leave and come back you must pick up a re-entry bracelet at the Scout pavilion (look for the flashing yellow light) before departing. Please be sure to show your bracelet at the gate upon re-entering the park.

The Friday night cracker-barrel will begin at 9:00 PM and is open to adults only. You may pick up your unit's patches at this time. Please remember to leave two-deep leadership in your campsite.

Campers must remain in the campground until 7:30 a.m. Saturday morning. This means no one is allowed in the paddock areas or any of the buildings on the property. Failure to observe this rule could result in your dismissal from the park.

For your safety, take a "buddy" along whenever you leave your tenting area.

Please adhere to the BSA policy on alcohol consumption: Scouting activities are not a place to possess or consume, alcoholic beverages. *GUIDE TO SAFE SCOUTING.* 

An adult leader or parent must accompany anyone under the age of 18 wishing to enter the paddock (pit) area. (Groups of Scouts may enter as long as there are two or more leaders present.) Please visit the paddock area after the races begin, not before. No one is allowed to touch or climb in/on cars unless the driver/owner is present and gives express permission.

If you are arriving on Saturday morning, please park as instructed by the park security personnel and proceed to the infield spectator area. You must have your tickets in your possession. Connecticut Yankee Council Scout Day at Lime Rock tickets are not available at the gate. Gates open at 7:30 AM Saturday morning. The last race ends at 5:00 PM. You should plan to be off property by 6:00 PM.

## Frequently asked questions:

<u>What should I bring?</u> Lime Rock is a unique motor sport venue in that all spectating is done from a grassy landscaped viewing area shaded by trees. For most comfort, blankets and lawn chairs are a must. You may also want to bring along insect repellant, suntan lotion and rain gear, just in case. You may bring a cooler but no glass containers are permitted.

<u>May we bring/ride bikes?</u> Yes, but <u>youth and adults must wear a helmet</u> at all times while riding and bike riding is restricted to the camping area only.

<u>Can I purchase food there?</u> Absolutely, the Paddock A concession stand will be open on Saturday from 7:30 am to approximately 4 pm.

**May I BBQ?** Yes, but only in the camping area and cooking must be done on a camp stove or bring your grill or hibachi. No ground fires please.

**<u>Can I bring my dog?</u>** No. Dogs are not allowed on the Lime Rock Park property during track events.

What if it rains? All road-racing events run rain or shine.

<u>What about those Hot Laps?</u> When available, Hot Laps will be awarded at the crackerbarrel along with information on when and where to assemble. Hot Lap participants must be 21 years or older and registered adult BSA members.

## How do I get there?

From New Haven: Take Rt. 34W to Rt. 8N to Torrington. Take Rt. 4W to Cornwall Bridge. Take Rt. 7N to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From Danbury: Take 84E to exit 7 (US-7N/US-202 Brookfield/New Milford). Continue on 7N for 30 mi. to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From the West: Take Rt. 84E to Route 22 North to Millerton. Take Rt. 44 East to Route 112 East. Main Entrance is on right, located on White Hollow Road.

The Main Gate entrance is at 60 White Hollow Rd, Lakeville, CT 06039. Directions are available on the Lime Rock website.
